I'll be leading a small tour to the BMW MOA National with a stop at Gold Beach, Oregon to take in the fabulous Jet Boat ride on the Rogue River.

The plan is to leave the Bay area around 8 am on Sat, the 10<sup>th</sup> in order to miss the tourist traffic on 101 N as much as possible. We have campground reservations at Klamath Campground in Klamath on the coast, which means a "tour" of 101 all the way. It's actually a fun road the further north you get.

As a special bonus, the campground is having a B-B-Q party and a campfire get together starting at 7pm so I'd like to arrive around 4-6 to setup and relax a bit.

Sunday morning, we have reservations at a campground right on the Rogue River at Gold Beach. This is a 2-hour ride from Klamath so breakfast, ride up the coast, set up the tent and be ready for the jet boat ride leaving the dock at noon. Dinner will be on the river so we should be back around 8 pm. Dress for getting wet but bring a warm jacket in case of fog.

Monday, we pack and have the options of either heading directly for Redmond and setting up for the Rally or dropping down and taking a tour of Crater Lake and showing up later that day in Redmond.

We will be allowed into the Redmond Fairgrounds early.
